Limitations

Not suitable for use on PE, PP, teflon.

Substrate praparation

Glued surfaces must be clean, dry and free from grease, dust and free particles.

Application instructions

It is neccessary that one of the glued surfaces is porous. If both surfaces is not porous, i tis necessary that a thin water film of about 10-20g/m2 is formed on one, e.g. with a damp cloth or sprayer. Then cut off the thread cover and put on the application tip and cut to the required width of bonding. Apply to one side of the joint.

When gluing large areas, cut the tip into a "V" joint. Placet he glued surfaces together during the open time of the glue (up to 5 minutes) and fix firmly until full hardening of the glue is achieved.

Store in a dry place. In unopened packages at temperatures +5°C to +25°C. Shelf life is 12 months (cartridge) and 6 months (tube) from the date of production.
